Mount Joy Secondary Plan Nearing Completion



The Mount Joy Secondary Plan is currently going through technical analysis that includes transportation and servicing studies. The Draft Plan is expected to be completed later this Spring with the final Plan expected by early 2023. The Plan will include a balance of residential and commercial uses. Numerous high density mixed use development applications have already been submitted to the City for consideration.

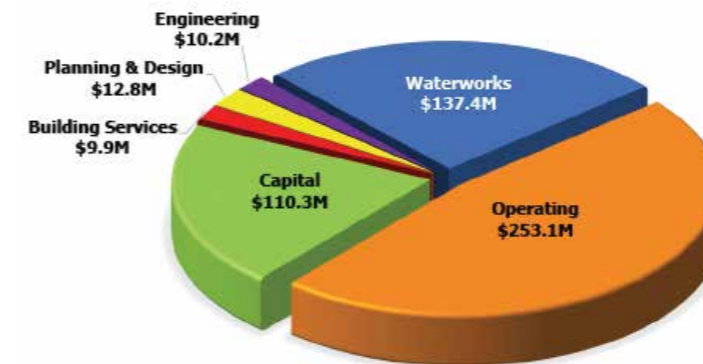
